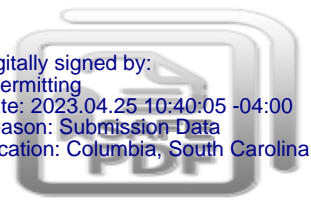

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### Form Purpose

The South Carolina Mining Act, Sections 48-20-10 through 48-20-310, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, as amended provides in part: "No operator may engage in mining without having first obtained from the Department an operating permit which covers the affected land and which has not been terminated, been revoked, suspended for the period in question, or otherwise become invalid." (Section 48-20-60). Section 48-20-55 states "The Department may develop and implement general permits for the regulation of mining limited to excavations for topsoil or sand/clay fill material which do not require further processing. General permits developed by the Department must contain at a minimum, standard plans and specifications for environmental protection, storm water management, public health and safety protection, and reclamation of affected lands in accordance with promulgated regulations."
