



West Nile Virus Testing in South Carolina by County SC DHEC Bureau of Laboratories, 2005


Number of Humans Tested by County as of 12/31/2005

Horses & Other Mammals Tested

Horses / mammals are not routinely tested at DHEC Bureau of Laboratories for WNV. On 11/28 however, one horse from Anderson County tested positive for WNV by Clemson University Veterinary Diagnostic Laboratories (CVDL).

Total numbers tested by CVDL by county are not known; therefore, no testing map is provided here. However, the six horses and 1 dog that were tested at DHEC BOL after being first tested at CVDL were from the following counties:

- 1 Beaufort
- 1 Charleston
- 1 Horry
- 1 Florence (dog)
- 3 County not specified

All were negative for WNV; however, the horse from Beaufort was positive for Eastern Equine Encephalitis.
