South Carolina's Department of Health and Environmental Control (DHEC) has completed the review of information submitted for the mine operating permit for Fairfield I-77 Quarry, requested by Luck Stone Corporation (Operator). This review process included information submitted by the Operator, comments from governmental agencies, and the interested public. With this approval and receipt of the required financial assurance, DHEC is issuing the Mine Operating Permit I-002329 for the Fairfield I-77 Quarry.
