NOTICE OF INTENT TO MODIFY A MINE OPERATING PERMIT

Martin Marietta Minerals, Inc. has applied to DHEC to modify the Orangeburg Quarry (limestone), Permit I-000802. The company requests to increase the permitted acreage by 1017.0 acres (to 2120.9 ac.), increase depth 40' (to 125'), and extend the reclamation schedule (from 2045 to 2112). Reclamation will be to lakes, woodlands, and grasslands. The mine is located at 950 County Line Road, Cross, SC in Orangeburg County, approximately 6.0 miles southeast of Eutawville, South Carolina. The mine permit application and related documents are available for review on DHEC's website at <https://www.scdhec.gov/environmental-public-notice>.

DHEC is currently conducting a technical review of the application and related documents and will accept written comments through **October 17, 2018**. Public comments may impact DHEC's permit decision by giving staff additional information to consider and could also be used when determining specific terms and conditions the company must follow if a permit is issued. Where there is a significant amount of public interest, DHEC may hold a public hearing.
