The South Carolina Administrative Procedures Act (APA) requires each state agency review its regulations every five years and submit an associated report to the Code Commissioner. S.C. Code Section 1-23-120(J) (Supp. 2016). The Department of Health and Environmental Control (“DHEC”) is conducting this review during the current fiscal year. As part of the review, DHEC seeks input from interested persons on whether amendments to DHEC’s current regulations are needed and, if so, what those amendments should be.
