

## **INTENT TO SOLE SOURCE**

The South Carolina Department of Health & Environmental Control (DHEC) is seeking a qualified vendor to provide hosting, maintenance, and customization as needed for the proprietary Med-IT System developed and sold by McCallie Associates, Inc. (Oxbow) for a period of one year.

Med-IT is a HIPAA secure web based data system that supports Best Chance Network (BCN) and WISEWOMAN data collection, prior authorization, bill and reimbursement and tracking of funds. Oxbow provides maintenance, help-desk support and implements all Centers for Disease Control (CDC) data requirements including data changes year to year as part of the maintenance package/fixed price subscription services and data storage. Additional services include hourly technical support to make data system changes as requested by the program area to meet individual support program needs. The Med-IT system is used by nine (9) federally funded Breast and Cervical Cancer Early Detection Program (BCCEDP) programs many of whom also have WISEWOMAN and colorectal screening programs

Requirements include but are not limited to: software maintenance, help desk support, hourly technical support and implementation of all CDC data requirements that update/change throughout the year.
