Sources of Income

This is defined as 'money from all sources <u>before</u> any deductions such as income taxes, social security taxes, insurance premiums, charitable contributions and bonds'.

SC DAP does not collect asset documentation.

Income Documentation

Documentation for income includes the following:

Salaries

• Business profits

• Social Security cash benefits

• Wages

- Rents, Interest, Dividends
- Unemployment compensation
- Workers compensation

Alimony

- Net earnings from selfemployment
- Scholarships
- Royalties and Commissions
- Child support

Income does not refer to the following:

Capital gains from primary residence; assets withdrawn from a bank; car; tax refunds; gifts; loans; lump-sum inheritances; one-time insurance payments. Compensation for injury must not be included as income unless it is received for DHEC provided treatment. The value of food and fuel produced and consumed on value of rent from a owner-occupied housing would also be exempt when computing a client's income.

The SC DAP retains the right to request additional information and/or documents to determine income eligibility. The SC DAP retains the right to change income eligibility requirements without notice.

Determining Household

The household is defined as the patient, the patient's spouse, dependent children, or dependent adults.
