## SUBJECT: Temporary Crushing and Screening Operations Registration Permit

Due to revisions to the Bureau of Air Quality Permitting Exemption List, the following changes will apply:

## **Temporary Crushing and Screening Operations**

As of November 1, 2018, all operators will be required to obtain a *"Registration Permit for Temporary Crushing and Screening Operations"* (Registration Permit).

The registration permit is a combined construction and operating permit for sources that meet the applicability requirements outlined in Section 1 of the permit.

Operators will have sixty (60) business days from the date of this memorandum to apply for the Registration permit. The application (DHEC-3976) can be located at: <u>https://www.scdhec.gov/permits-regulations/forms-applications-registration-reporting-etc</u> and must be submitted no later than February 6, 2019.

## Asphalt/Concrete Facilities

All facilities adding new emission sources that are subject to 40 CFR 60 New Source Performance Standards (NSPS standards) are required to obtain a construction permit, per SC Regulation 61-62.1, Section II(B)(2). The construction permit requirement does not apply to the addition of emergency engines.
