Authorized and funded under the [EPA's Water Infrastructure Improvements for the Nation \(WIIN\) Act](#), SC's Lead Testing in Schools and Child Care Programs grant provides free water lead testing to schools and child care programs across the state. Participation in this program is voluntary. This grant allows DHEC to test water from a school's or child care provider's faucets for lead at no cost to the facility.

## The Enrollment Process is as Easy as 1, 2, 3

1. Enroll in the program by completing the **Online Facility Survey** located on the program website at [scdhec.gov/bow/lead-testing-schools-child-care-programs](https://scdhec.gov/bow/lead-testing-schools-child-care-programs)
2. Participate in a virtual walkthrough to determine drinking water consumption locations within the facility
3. Participate in a site visit by a professional water operator to collect water samples
4. Analysis of samples by the DHEC Lab
5. Receive sampling results and communications packet
