



Notice of Availability Emergency General Permits (EGP) Hurricane Matthew

The Department has implemented the following Emergency General Permits (EGP) due to Hurricane Matthew.

1. EGP-M-001 – Docks (Private, Joint-use and Community)
2. EGP-M-002 – Commercial Docks & Marinas
3. EGP-M-003 – Non-Oceanfront Erosion Control Structures
4. EGP-M-004 – Oceanfront Fishing Piers

These General Permit(s) only apply to the reconstruction and repair of previously permitted or grandfathered docks, marinas, non-oceanfront erosion control structures and oceanfront fishing piers. The EGPs will be available from the date of the event, October 8, 2016 until October 8, 2021. Individual coverage under the available Emergency General Permits must be obtained from the Department. To obtain coverage under the EGPs, the attached application and requested information must be submitted to the below address. The Department will work expeditiously to review and issue decisions on each request.
