Facilities and Services <u>Still</u> <u>Requiring</u> CON

- Nursing homes
- Home health agencies
- MUSC acquisitions of hospitals
- Hospitals (general & specialized) before undertaking:
 - the construction or other establishment of a hospital except 1)
 relocation of a hospital in the same county, 2) construction of a new
 hospital up to 50 beds in a county currently without a hospital, and/or
 3) the merger or acquisition of hospital)
 - the addition of beds or the change in licensing classification of beds
 - Note: Effective January 1, 2027, CON is repealed for hospital projects

- Ambulatory Surgical Facilities (ASFs)
- Cardiovascular Care Services
- Community Long-Term Care (CLTC) Program
- Freestanding Emergency Departments (FSEDs)
- Hospice Facilities

- Obstetrical Services
- Opioid (Narcotic)Treatment Programs
- Radiation Oncology
- Residential Treatment
 Facilities for Children and
 Adolescents (RTFs)

Home Health Agencies

Changed standards to allow an applicant to submit **one** Certificate of Need (CON) application for the number of counties proposed to serve
