

INTENT TO SOLE SOURCE

The South Carolina Department of Health & Environmental Control (DHEC) is seeking a qualified vendor to provide:

- (1) One AB SCIEX X500R Liquid Chromatograph Quadrupole Time of Flight Mass Spectrometer (LC-QTOF) system for the DHEC Public Health Laboratory. The system will be used to analyze clinical specimens with High Resolution mass Spectrometry capabilities, detecting low-level compounds amidst an abundance of co-eluting matrix compounds. Offeror's system must be compatible with the same X500R software, consumables, and parts as the existing AB SCIEX X500R currently in use at the Public Health Laboratory. The estimated total dollar amount of the purchase, including shipping is \$350,000.
- (2) One-year service plan coverage for the existing AB SCIEX X500R QTOF mass spectrometer system, associated instrument software support and hardware telephone technical support, currently in use at the DHEC Public Health Laboratory. Service plan coverage is to include performance maintenance visits by a factory-trained service representative, manufacturer OEM parts replacement as needed for corrective maintenance and repair, while maintaining the standard level of performance as stated in the operational manual provided with the original equipment. The estimated total dollar amount of the purchase is \$67,000.

PROTESTS:

If you are aggrieved in connection with the intended award or award of the contract, you may be entitled to protest, but only as provided in Section 11-35-4210. To protest an award, you must (i) submit notice of your intent to protest within five (5) business days of the date this notice is posted, and (ii) submit your actual protest within fifteen days of the date this notice is posted. Days are calculated as provided in Section 11-35-310(13). Both protests and notices of intent to protest must be in writing and must be received by the appropriate Chief Procurement Officer within the time provided. The grounds of the protest and the relief requested must be set forth with enough particularity to give notice of the issues to be decided.
