The South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (the Department) has reviewed the above referenced work plan. The work plan is approved for implementation. The Department notes that the proposed investigation is limited to the Brenntag property, however the contaminant plume is known to extend beyond the property boundary. The Department's approval of this work plan does not preclude the possibility that additional investigation may be required in order to facilitate design and implementation of a remedial action to address the groundwater plume. Temporary Monitoring Well Approval 12557 is attached.

This approval is for the installation of up to thirty (30) temporary monitoring wells. The wells are to be installed in the locations illustrated and constructed per the specifications proposed in the Work Plan for Area #2 – Rev. 1 dated September 25, 2020. These wells are to be installed and abandoned following all of the applicable requirements of R.61-71.

Please note that R.61-71. requires the following:

1. All wells shall be drilled, constructed, and abandoned by a South Carolina certified well driller per R.61-71.D.1.
2. A Water Well Record Form 1903 or other form provided and/or approved by the Department shall be completed and submitted to the Department within 30 days after well completion or abandonment unless another schedule has been approved by the Department. The form should contain the “as-built” construction details and all other information required by R.61-71.H.1.f.
3. All analytical data obtained from each boring shall be submitted to the Department within 30 days of receipt of laboratory results as required by R.61-71.H.1.d unless another schedule has been approved by the Department.
4. All temporary monitoring wells shall be properly abandoned within five (5) days of borehole completion as required by R.61-71.H.4.c
5. If any of the information provided to the Department changes, including the proposed drilling date, the Author shall be notified at least twenty-four (24) hours prior to well construction as required by R.61-71.H.1.a

This approval is pursuant to the provisions of Section 44-55-40 of the 1976 South Carolina Code of Laws and R.61-71 of the South Carolina Well Standards, dated April 26, 2002.
