The South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (the Department) has received and reviewed the above referenced document. The following comments were generated during this review.

- 1. The Department appreciates the effort given to coordinating with the adjacent property owner to sample concurrently, as well as the inclusion of the Groundwater Quality Summary Table.
- 2. The Department concurs with the proposed use of vacuum enhanced recovery to collect free phase liquids and contaminated groundwater from MW-12.
- 3. The Department is in receipt of an electronic copy of the work plan for additional groundwater assessment in the vicinity of MW-11, and will be reviewing this plan in the coming weeks.
- 4. The Department is also awaiting a plan to assess the potential for vapor intrusion.

The next semiannual report should be submitted to by attention on or before December 31, 2018. Please contact me if you would like to set up a meeting with the Department or to discuss this project.
