The South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control's (DHEC) Bureau of Land and Waste Management (BLWM) and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) are announcing the initiation of a public comment period on the USACE's Draft Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement (SEIS) and a request to modify a mine operating permit for the Haile Gold Mine. USACE and DHEC intend to hold a joint virtual public hearing.

The Draft SEIS is available for review online at <u>http://hailegoldmineseis.com/</u>. Hard copies are available for review at the Kershaw County Library – Camden branch [address: 1304 Broad St, Camden, SC 29020 phone: (803) 425-1508] and the Kershaw Depot [address: 106 N. Cleveland Street, Kershaw, SC 29067, phone: (803) 475-3201]. There are COVID measures in place at the library and Kershaw Depot for public safety; for any questions or if you prefer to make an appointment to review the Draft SEIS, please call ahead.

The intent to modify a mine operating permit is located at <u>http://scdhec.gov/HaileMine</u>. The request is to continue mining gold and to add approximately 832 acres to the mine operating permit, increase overburden and tailing storage capacity, increase processing plant efficiency, increase water storage capacity, and initiate underground mining operations. Proposed land uses following reclamation include lake/pond, grasslands, and woodlands.

The virtual public hearing will be held on April 1, 2021, at 6:30 pm eastern standard time, to accept oral and written comments on the Draft SEIS for the Haile Gold Mine, Inc.'s proposed mine expansion and DHEC's consideration of a proposed modification to the Haile Gold Mine Permit (I-000601) in Kershaw, SC.

The public hearing is a formal opportunity for comments to be heard by DHEC and USACE staff and to be recorded by a court reporter. The agencies' representatives will not respond to any questions or comments during the public hearing. The public hearing will be conducted in a respectful, orderly manner with reasonable limits on the length of comments, if necessary.

Anyone who plans to participate in the joint public hearing should complete the registration form on the DHEC webpage <u>https://www.scdhec.gov/HaileMine</u> prior to March 30, 2021. Everyone who completes the registration form will be provided instructions on how to join the joint public hearing from a phone, computer, or mobile device. The public hearing will be recorded and the recording will be posted on the DHEC and USACE webpages no later than April 9, 2021.
