Subject: Public Notice of Draft Permit and Public Hearing MRR Pickens, LLC | Highway 93 Class 2 Landfill Modification 2180 Greenville Highway Liberty, Pickens County, South Carolina

MRR Pickens, LLC received a permit from DHEC in November 2008 to construct and operate the Highway 93 Class 2 Landfill. While the landfill has not yet been constructed, the permit has remained in place and effective since that time. MRR is currently requesting to update the maximum annual disposal rate for the landfill from 70,500 tons per year (TPY) to 175,339 TPY. The maximum annual disposal rate is the amount of waste that may be received at a landfill during a fiscal year and is determined by using data reported in the most recent S.C. Solid Waste Management Annual Report. Increasing the tonnage rate is considered a major modification to the existing permit. A draft permit has been written to incorporate the proposed tonnage increase and is open for public comment. The enclosed public notice for the draft permit will be published in the *Pickens County Courier* and *The Sentinel-Progress* newspapers on April 6, 2022.

DHEC will hold a virtual public hearing on April 28, 2022, at 6:30 pm, to accept oral comments on the draft permit. Anyone can join remotely using a phone, computer, or other mobile device. The public hearing is formal and provides an opportunity for comments to be recorded by a court reporter. There will be no questions and answers during the public hearing.
