The South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (the Department) has reviewed the Results of the 72-Hour AFVR that was conducted in September 2020. The following comments are provided based on this review.

1. The absence of measurable negative pressure within monitoring wells MW-9 and MW-14 suggest that the radius of influence for the AFVR is limited.
2. The recovery of 15.3 gallons of VOC mass is significant, and indicates that while the radius of influence is limited, the technology is effective within those limits. Contaminant trends suggest that ongoing AFVR events will continue to remove significant mass.
3. AFVR should be continued pending selection of a final remedy for Area #2.
