

**1. Darlington County EMS**

**Investigation and Violations:** Department staff investigated a self-reported incident involving Darlington County EMS. Department staff determined Darlington County EMS violated statute by allowing an uncertified person to perform patient care on nine calls. The uncertified person allowed his certification to expire.

**Enforcement:** On February 12, 2024, the Department notified Darlington County EMS that it was considering enforcement action. Darlington County EMS and Department staff agreed to resolve this via a Consent Order, which was executed on March 11, 2024. Darlington County EMS agreed to the assessment of a \$1,100 monetary penalty.

**Remedial Action:** Darlington County EMS paid the monetary penalty.

**2. Jelani Sargeant**

**Investigation and Violations:** Department staff investigated a self-reported incident involving Mr. Sargeant. Department staff determined Mr. Sargeant committed misconduct, as defined by statute and regulation, in that he created a substantial possibility that death or serious physical harm could result from his actions or inactions. Department staff further determined Mr. Sargeant failed to provide a patient emergency medical treatment of a quality deemed acceptable by the Department, including failure to meet generally accepted standards for provision of care.

**Enforcement:** On January 10, 2024, the Department notified Mr. Sargeant that it was considering enforcement action. On January 26, 2024, Mr. Sargeant and Department staff met for an enforcement

conference. The parties agreed to resolve this via a Consent Order, which was executed on March 15, 2024. Mr. Sargeant agreed to the assessment of a \$100 monetary penalty. He also agreed to successfully complete the following classes within six months: Professional Ethics and Personal Leadership (PEPL); in-person class on Advanced Medical Life Support (ALMS); and Advance Airway. Finally, Mr. Sargeant agreed to be demoted to an Advanced EMT certificate for a period of 90 days.

**Remedial Action:** As of April 22, 2024, the Department has not received payment of the monetary penalty or evidence of completion of the required classes/courses.

**Prior Orders:** None in the past 5 years.

### **3. Breck Granger**

**Investigation and Violations:** Department staff investigated an incident involving Mr. Granger. Department staff determined Mr. Granger committed misconduct, as defined by statute and regulation, in that he created a substantial possibility that death or serious physical harm could result from his actions or inactions. Department staff further determined Mr. Granger failed to provide a patient emergency medical treatment of a quality deemed acceptable by the Department, including failure to meet generally accepted standards for provision of care.

**Enforcement:** On January 10, 2024, the Department notified Mr. Granger that it was considering enforcement action. On January 26, 2024, Mr. Granger and Department staff met for an enforcement conference. The parties agreed to resolve this via a Consent Order, which was executed on March 15, 2024. Mr. Granger agreed to the assessment of a \$100 monetary penalty. He also agreed to successfully complete the following classes within six months: Professional Ethics and Personal Leadership (PEPL); in-person class on Advanced Medical Life Support (ALMS); and Advance Airway. Finally, Mr. Granger agreed to be demoted to an Advanced EMT certificate for a period of 90 days.

**Remedial Action:** As of April 22, 2024, the Department has not received payment of the monetary penalty or evidence of completion of the required classes/courses.

Action: The Individual/Entity is required to submit all remaining supplemental information required to process the mining application submitted November 16, 2022, or begin reclamation tasks to include: submission of an updated reclamation schedule to include the two growing seasons, and completion of reclamation within seven hundred thirty (730) days of the execution date of the Consent Order; create final slopes in all excavation areas at an angle as to minimize the possibility of slides and consistent with the future use of the land and not steeper than a 3:1 slope; use appropriate conservation practices for controlling both on-site and off-site erosion and siltation; and establish, on a continuing basis, the vegetative cover and soil stability appropriate to the area, in that the area should be seeded with native grasses or other suitable ground cover to establish and maintain, into the second growing season, a 75% or greater permanent vegetive cover with no substantial bare spots. The Department has assessed a total civil penalty in the amount of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00). The Individual/Entity shall pay a civil penalty in the amount of one thousand dollars (**\$1,000.00**) by April 15, 2024.

Summary: Granby Millpond NRDE, LLC (Individual/Entity) owns and is responsible for the proper operation and maintenance of a pool located in Lexington County, South Carolina. The Department conducted inspections on June 15, 2023, and August 3, 2023, and violations were issued for failure to properly operate and maintain. The Individual/Entity has violated the Public Swimming Pools Regulation as follows: there was debris in the skimmer baskets; a skimmer was missing a weir; skimmer baskets were floating; there was no drinking water fountain; a minimum six inch air gap was not maintained at the backwash discharge point; the pool equipment room was not locked; a gate did not self-close and latch; a section of the perimeter fence had openings greater than four inches; the chlorine level was not within the acceptable range of water quality standards; the life ring was not United States Coast Guard approved; the shepherd's crook was not properly mounted in its designated location and was not clear of obstructions; the bound and numbered log book was not maintained on a daily basis and was not maintained a minimum of three times per week by the pool operator of record; the cyanuric acid level was not checked weekly; and the water level was too low.

Action: The Individual/Entity has corrected all violations. The Department has assessed a total civil penalty in the amount of six hundred eighty dollars (\$680.00). The Individual/Entity shall pay a civil penalty in the amount of six hundred eighty dollars (**\$680.00**).

Update: The civil penalty has been paid and the Consent Order is closed.

Action: The Individual/Entity is required to: cover the pool with a commercially manufactured pool cover or drain the pool of stagnant water and contact Department staff to schedule an inspection for Department staff to verify completion of the work by April

10, 2024; correct all deficiencies and any upgrades required to bring the pool into compliance with Regulation 61-51, and contact the Department to schedule an inspection to verify completion of the work by August 8, 2024. The Individual/Entity will be required to properly fill in or remove the pool within sixty days of the date of written notification by the Department if the requirement to bring the pool into compliance with Regulation 61-51 is not met within the specified timeline. The Department has assessed a total civil penalty in the amount of four hundred dollars (\$400.00). The Individual/Entity shall pay a **stipulated penalty** in the amount of four hundred dollars (**\$400.00**) should any requirement of the Order not be met.
