- 2. Letter from the state regulatory agency or health authority stating that the plant(s) is permitted or licensed as required, has a source water supply meeting all EPA public drinking water requirements, and is operated and maintained in a sanitary manner based on previous plant inspection(s).
- 3. Copy of the latest finished product water analyses (total coliform, inorganic, organic, radiological).
- 4. Copy of product label for regulatory review.
- 5. Location(s) where the product may be sampled in South Carolina.
