-**The Electronic Reporting Team:** is soliciting feedback from all entities that report data to the South Carolina Central Cancer Registry (SCCCR). We are creating a tracking tool with information about the entity's cancer registry software applications they use, what EMR is used at your facility, and which version of the SCCCR edits are currently being used to make sure your submission files are edit error free.
