In summary, it identifies 80 providers, statewide. It maps their service areas, and there are a variety of different details for the providers. You can select a specific county, an information box will appear to list providers who are willing to go to a site to provide the COVID vaccine. Some providers will go to a specific county, while others will travel up to 100 miles. This map seems to answer a lot of questions we have been discussing. This was created for community partners to locate a provider in a specific area to do onsite COVID vaccinations.</li> <li>• Per Chief Mitchum, the link is listed on the agenda. Is it available to the public? Per Taylor, no, it is more for community partners that have a population who cannot travel to a vaccine site. If you have other leaders who would like to have access, please feel to share.</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Per Chief Mitchum, can we turn over the spreadsheet that Tara created? Per Taylor, he believes the map will encompass the spreadsheet. Providers can be added to the map.</li> <li>• Per Raymond Bartee, there are 4-5 questions on the link that they would like to have answered for the providers, so it is targeted towards the providers. This will allow us to click on an area to see available providers. On June 1<sup>st</sup>, DHEC will start a homebound vaccination program. Those who are homebound and need a vaccine will contact our vaccine information line (1-866-365-8110). We have a couple of providers who are willing to go to homebound individuals to provide the COVID vaccine.</li> </ul>

Mobile Unit/ “COVID No More” Targeted Vaccine Campaign Panel Outreach Collaboration	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Per Chief Mitchum, since we have the PSA material and the CUPP Map, do we need to move forward with the “COVID No More” Campaign? Per Letisha Scotland, can we see what the month of June looks like and reevaluate at the end of June? Everyone is in agreement.</li> </ul>
