As South Carolina moves from containment strategy to a disease mitigation strategy, there's less focus on the number of individual cases in an area and more focus on limiting overall spread throughout the state. It's important to know:

- There are many people within our communities who have the virus and have never been tested, and because of this, we'll never have information that accurately represents every case of COVID-19.
- Regardless of the number of reported cases within an area, all South Carolinians should take seriously the recommended precautions for protecting against this disease. This geographic listing by ZIP code is a reference to reported positive cases, but it doesn't account for likely cases of COVID-19 within a community.
- This information shows reported cases for the previous 14 days, an estimate for when individuals may be contagious.
