


What is SCRIPTS?

The South Carolina Prescription Monitoring Program, known as SCRIPTS (South Carolina Reporting & Identification Tracking System), collects information on controlled substances (Schedules II, III, IV prescriptions dispensed in South Carolina. The SCRIPTS website allows approved practitioners and pharmacists to view a patient's prescription history.

SCRIPTS' mission


SCRIPTS is intended to improve the state's ability to identify and stop diversion of prescription drugs in anefficient and cost-effective manner. The program will not impede on the appropriate medical utilization oflicit controlled substances where there is a valid patient-provider relationship.

Reporting requirements

All dispensers in South Carolina, including mail order pharmacies who ship into South Carolina, are required to report their dispensations to the data repository daily. SCRIPTS' database includes all CII-IV dispensations that were dispensed in South Carolina.

PMPi (Interstate) & Integration

As of 05/2023, South Carolina interstate data shareswith 46 other states. Currently, we do not connect with California, Oregon, Wyoming, Nebraska, and Vermont.
